The second meeting of the European Regional Process (ERP) for the fifth World Water Forum in Istanbul 2009 will take place on the **8th and 9th of July in Zaragoza**, **Spain**. The programme will start at 1500 on the 8<sup>th</sup> and finish at 1600 on the 9<sup>th</sup>. The goal of this meeting is to discuss the overall Process and the progress within the eight themes of the ERP as well as to identify the next steps that will have to be taken to prepare the European input to the World Water Forum. Furthermore, taking place in Zaragoza, it will focus on receiving the Southern European input in the European Regional Process.

## **Objectives of the meeting**

After the first meeting in February in Brussels, which identified the themes relevant for Europe and an initial list of organisations willing to work on them, this second meeting will discuss progress within these themes and next steps to be taken to prepare the European input. To achieve this, the programme has been divided into a plenary session and workshops on the different themes.

The **plenary session** will address the general activities of the European Regional Process, explaining the work done so far, discussing the European Regional Document as well as the European Regional Session in Istanbul and any other initiatives we could undertake. Furthermore it will identify any missing issues which should be addressed, specifically from a Southern perspective.

The **workshops** will each focus on one of the themes of the European Regional Process, which are listed below. The objective is to discuss the work that has already been executed, identify next steps to be taken as well as identify which sessions to focus on in Istanbul. The workshops will again aim specifically to incorporate the Southern European input.

The themes of the European Regional Process are:

- Future of Water in Europe
- Climate Change and Adaptation
- Water for Energy, Energy for Water
- Basin Management and Transboundary Cooperation
- Finance
- Sanitation
- Water Scarcity and Droughts
- Water Science and Technologies



The workshops will be organised in two sessions, on the afternoon of the 8<sup>th</sup> and on the afternoon of the 9<sup>th</sup> of July. This will give you the opportunity to attend two different workshops on two different themes. Please indicate on the registration form which themes are most interesting to you, in order of preference. We will take these preferences into account as much as possible in setting up the final programme.

## Hotelrooms

Because of the logistical difficulties of finding hotelrooms in Zaragoza we have reserved a limited number of hotelrooms for reasonable prices in advance for the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> of July.
