ABOUT PREVIOUS FORA

1st World Water Forum, Marrakech, Morocco, 1997

The Marrakech Declaration gave the World Water Council the mandate to produce a long-term "Vision for Water, Life and the Environment in the 21st Century".

2nd World Water Forum, The Hague, The Netherlands, 2000

The World Water Vision for the 21st Century, prepared in consultation with 15,000 individuals around the world, was presented, aiming to "Make Water Everybody's Business". The Ministerial Conference and an Expowere associated with the Forum for the first time.

3rd World Water Forum, Kyoto, Shiga and Osaka, Japan, 2003

24,000 participants made this the biggest world water event yet. It was defined as a Forum open to all, as being created through the participation of all, and translated the World Water Vision into concrete actions through the World Water Actions report and the Portfolio of Water Actions.

4th World Water Forum, Mexico City, Mexico, 2006

Building on the World Water Vision and Actions, the 4th Forum focused on "Local Actions for a Global Challenge", and collected over 1400 local actions from around the world. Over 200 multi-stakeholder sessions brought forth recommendations for Ministers, Mayors and Parliamentarians.

ISTANBUL

VENUE

The Golden Horn Congress and Exhibition Centre, in the heart of Istanbul's Golden Horn, commands a unique view of Istanbul and has been restored to its original state at the time of the Ottoman Empire. The multipurpose 157,000 m² facility can easily meet the requirements of large and special events. It is accessible by air, sea and land, since a heliport, a 1 km long pier facility, and car park are available. Nearby accommodation, with numerous hotels in Taksim, in Eminönü, Aksaray and around the airport makes it convenient for participants to arrive on site.
